This magnificent waterside family retreat on Mecox Bay was designed by Selldorf Associates with a garden by Abby Lawless of Farm Design. The house is grounded within a sequence of meadow inspired plantings with an entry meadow composed of sculptural trees, grasses and mints with subtle tones of silver, blue, grey, rust red and green. Lyn and James Adamson Garden

The Adamson Garden, designed by Frederico Azevedo, of Unlimited Earth Care, is calm with a presence of color, and is both romantic and structured all at the same time. The gardens are divided into two levels: the upper garden is a full-sun garden and the lower garden is a shade garden that edges Kellis Pond. The use of different textures, colors and heights, including native plants such as: Baptista, Cimicifuga, Echinacea, Ferns, American Holly and Arrowwood Viburnum make the design simple and ultimately elegant.
