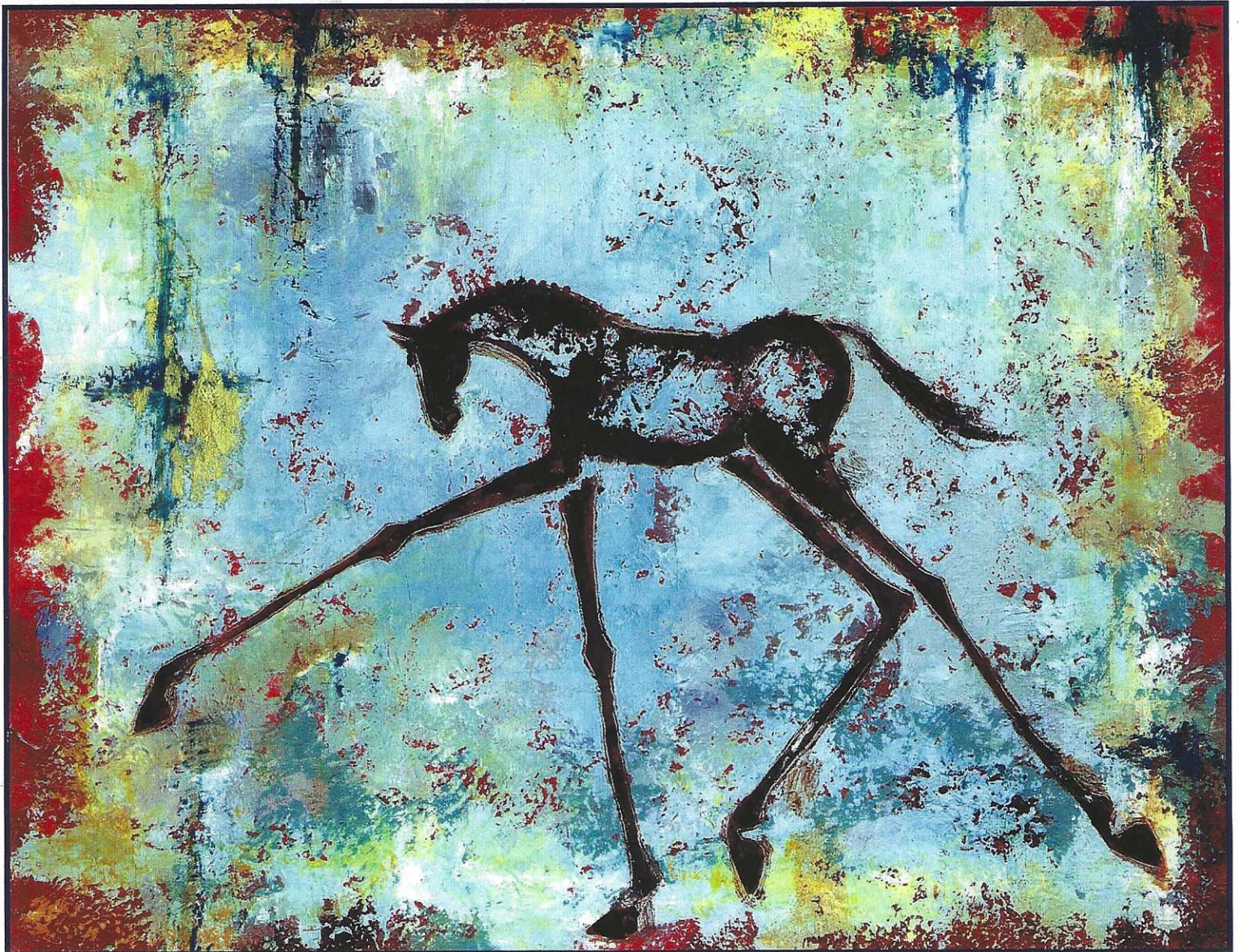

**CEO, FOUNDER, AND LANDSCAPE DESIGNER
UNLIMITED EARTH CARE**

What has been your best moment in business?
There have been many important moments over the years. The publishing and success of my book, "Bloom: The Luminous Gardens of Frederico Azevedo" represented over two decades of my career, and was an opportunity to reflect on my process and on natural design as a medium. The opening of The Garden Market is an important piece of the Unlimited Earth Care story because I'm now able to share the elements of a sustainable UEC garden.

What is your secret to success?
I'm very thankful and I work very hard. I'm at the office every day before 7am, and I consider every detail of both the business and the design side of my firm to be equally important. I create tailored natural experiences for every client, so I commit to taking the time to really plan out a design that will not only look beautiful on their property, but also be healthy and sustainable.

Who inspires you?
The Brazilian designers Lota de Macedo Soares and Roberto Burle Marx inspired me to do what I do by showing me how transformative well-designed natural spaces can be. My mentor when I studied in England, the late Robin Williams, remains an important figure in my work. I'm also inspired of course, by nature, who I collaborate with daily to create atmospheres and spaces that are equal parts its wild influence and my careful planning.

Eboné M. Bishop is the Founder and CEO of Evolv. Eboné has long been interested in shifting global demographics and cultural norms, and how organizations respond to these changes. She founded the firm in 2018 to bring her expertise as an attorney and her lived experiences to help others understand and effect positive change in this space. Eboné serves as Co-Chair of the Board of Directors of the Astraea Lesbian Foundation for Justice, a public foundation that advances LGBTQI human rights across the world; is a Senior Fellow and Member of the American Planning Board of Humanity in Action, an international educational organization that promotes human rights, diversity and active citizenship; and is a member of the Junior Board of The Osborne Association, which creates opportunities for, and advocates on behalf of, people affected by the criminal justice system. She received her B.A. in Politics from Brandeis University and her J.D. from Fordham University School of Law. Her early career as a corporate transactions attorney brought her to live and work in Asia, where she specialized in mergers and acquisitions and market entry risk mitigation. She has also worked on domestic fraud investigations and several high-profile international criminal investigations. Eboné currently calls Brooklyn home.



ISAAC BOOTS

**CELEBRITY TRAINER, CHOREOGRAPHER,
BROADWAY DANCER
TORCH'D SHOPPE**

Born and raised in Hawaii and dubbed the breakout fitness star by the New York Times, Isaac Boots is a philanthropist, choreographer, and Broadway dancer with a long list of credits to his name.

In March of 2020, due to the pandemic lockdown, Isaac offered his TORCH'D work-out classes every day free of charge on Instagram Live. In lieu of paying him, Boots asked his followers to donate what they could to No Kid Hungry, the charity known for providing meals to kids in need.

Astonishingly, Boots' effort raised over \$1.5 Million for No Kid Hungry, making him the single largest individual fundraiser in the organization's history.

Boots' new \$1 Million fundraising effort is for the World Childhood Foundation. They focus on protecting children from sex exploitation, violence and sexual abuse.

Boots has trained and worked with superstars in TV/Film, Broadway & music, including Gwyneth Paltrow, Jessica Chastain, Kelly Ripa, Vanessa Hudgens, Lisa Rinna, Ariana Grande, Priyanka Chopra, Naomi Watts, Brooke Shields, Lucy Liu, and Faye Dunaway to name a few.



LOUIS BRADBURY

**PRESIDENT
THE CALAMUS FOUNDATION**

For nearly the past twenty years, Louis Bradbury has been the president of the Calamus Foundation, which has granted over \$30 million to support important initiatives of a wide range of diverse LGBT organizations.

Bradbury served as President of the Board of Gay Men's Health Crisis from 1993 to 1997 during which time GMHC created a state of the art HIV testing center generously funded by the David Geffen Foundation. He has also served on several other boards including the National Suicide Prevention Foundation, Planned Parenthood of NYC, the Point Foundation, the National and Gay Task Force, the Education Alliance and Making Gay History.

He graduated from Northwestern University, where he served on the Visiting Committee and was honored in 2000 with the Alumni Merit Award, and from Harvard Law School. He lives in New York with his husband Ken Quay.
