For Holiday House Design Show founder and interior designer Iris Dankner, a 23-year breast cancer survivor, COVID-19 is not the first challenge she's faced. Dankner has held the annual summer Hamptons and fall Manhattan showhouse to benefit the Breast Cancer Research Foundation, yet this year that proved impossible. "The health and safety of our staff, design community and visitors are our top priorities, and we know that breast cancer patients and survivors are at an even higher risk," she says.

Soon after her diagnosis at age 40, Dankner dove deep into fundraising for the cause. "I realized I had two full-time jobs: I was a full-time interior designer and a full-time fundraiser. And I loved both of my lives. My dream was to find a way to combine my two passions, and that's how Holiday House started." After its inception in 2008, Holiday House is now one of the premier showhouses in the country. "In an effort to move forward with our new 'normal,' we decided to produce a virtual designer showhouse to continue raising money for breast cancer research and keep our community engaged and safe during the summer months," Dankner says.
