




IN BLOOM

For over 25 years, North Haven resident Frederico Azevedo has curated a style for landscape design that has inspired his clientele at the Bridgehampton-based Unlimited Earth Care. This summer, landscape enthusiasts will be able to take a page, literally, from Azevedo, with the debut of his first book, "Bloom: The Luminous Gardens of Frederico Azevedo," which will be published by Pointed Leaf Press.

When Azevedo started out on the South Fork, founding Unlimited Earth Care in 1993, he began crafting his aesthetic, which was a sharp departure from the minimalist gardens that were en-vogue at the time. "I was coming from Brazil and England, thinking in full color," says Azevedo.

Photographs explore the hallmarks of Azevedo's gardens — signature, curving floral borders, a commitment to integrating native plants into the landscape and multi-dimensional vistas that rely on the repetition of color, texture and shape to create a romantic and elegant aesthetic. "The curve generates a question, the impression that it's going somewhere — somewhere somewhat obscured," Azevedo says of layering flowers, trees, grasses, shrubs and hedges in a curve in his designs, which remain true to his original inspiration, color, with vibrant reds and pinks mixing in with vivid yellows and paths of soft purple and white flowers.

"Bloom: The Luminous Gardens of Frederico Azevedo" will be available this summer and will retail for \$75 through pointedleafpress.com.
